- 10. Click on "Submit Registration."

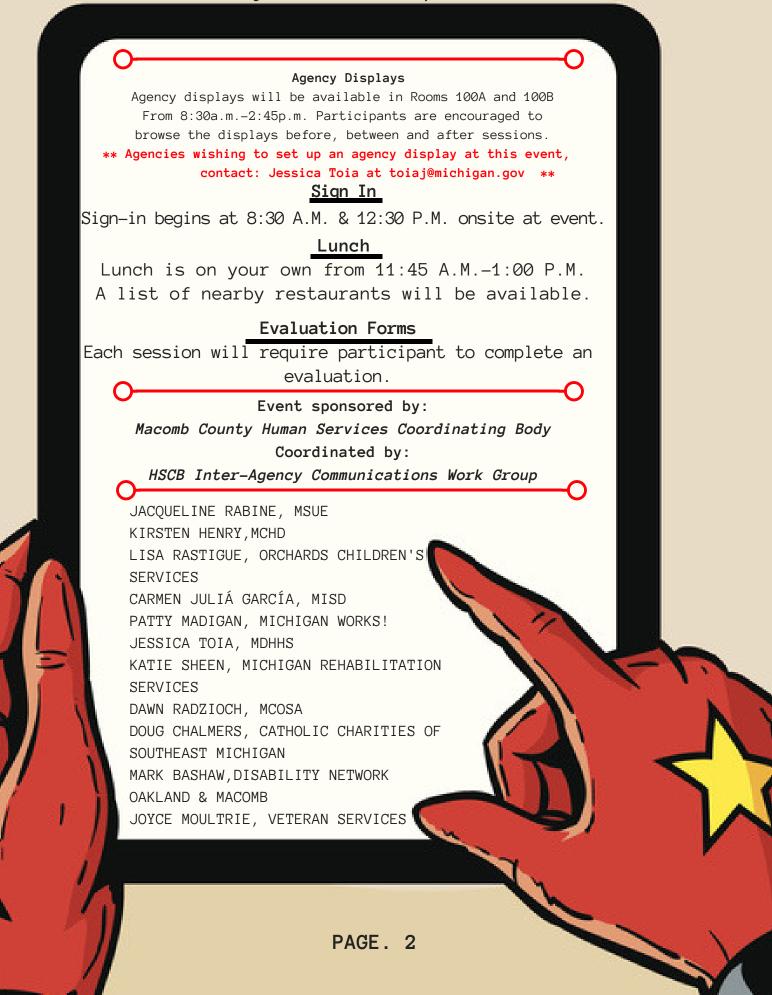
