DESCRIPTION:

3. Learn about investing at Michigan 4-H website at <https://www.canr.msu.edu/4-h-money-smarts/>
4. Beginning in April you will receive an e-mail with the Kahoot! challenge code. Preview the questions before taking the challenge.
Your first score counts.
5. Complete the challenge using the code by April 30, 2019. The Kahoot! challenge will take approximately 20 minutes to complete. Winners will be announced by May 15, 2019.
