## GHS Intensive Crisis Stabilization Services for Children and Young Adults

**The GHS Intensive Crisis Stabilization Team (ICSS)** provides mobile crisis stabilization services at no cost, 7 days a week between 8:00am and 7:00pm to all children, youth, and young adults (ages 0-21) who reside in Genesee County. Calls during other hours are helped by our Crisis Line mental health professionals.

## **Reasons to call GHS:**

- If you feel your child/youth is in a crisis
- The child/youth may hurt themselves or others
- The child is experiencing overwhelming confusion, anger, or emotional unresponsiveness
- If you feel you cannot independently manage the situation

If you aren't sure if ICSS is needed, give us a call and we can help to explore options.

## What happens when the GHS Intensive Crisis Team is called?

The team will provide on site intervention. Their main focus is to help to de-escalate the situation and determine the next best steps for you and your family.

## Other services include:

- Crisis and Safety Planning
- Referrals
- Linking to Resources
- Psychiatric consults as needed (does not include medication review for prescription)
