

GHS Intensive Crisis Stabilization Services for Children and Young Adults



The GHS Intensive Crisis Stabilization Team (ICSS) provides mobile crisis stabilization services at no cost, 7 days a week between 8:00am and 7:00pm to all children, youth, and young adults (ages 0-21) who reside in Genesee County. Calls during other hours are helped by our Crisis Line mental health professionals.

Reasons to call GHS:

- If you feel your child/youth is in a crisis
- The child/youth may hurt themselves or others
- The child is experiencing overwhelming confusion, anger, or emotional unresponsiveness
- If you feel you cannot independently manage the situation

If you aren't sure if ICSS is needed, give us a call and we can help to explore options.

What happens when the GHS Intensive Crisis Team is called?

The team will provide on site intervention. Their main focus is to help to de-escalate the situation and determine the next best steps for you and your family.

Other services include:

- Crisis and Safety Planning
- Referrals
- Linking to Resources
- Psychiatric consults as needed (does not include medication review for prescription)
