"Co-occurring Addiction and PTSD"

Steve has over 27 years experience working with numerous clinically complex populations, including individuals with co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders, individuals with personality disorders, trauma survivors, juvenile offenders, and County jail inmates. Currently serving as the Director of Foundations Detroit, an outpatient clinic that is part of the nationwide Foundations Recovery Network, Steve previously worked for over 20 years in Michigan's Community Mental Health system. He also currently teaches in the School of Social Work at the University of Michigan and is a popular conference speaker and trainer. Steve's own lived experience of dual disorders and dual recovery has been a core element informing his clinical practice and teaching work.

"Understanding your Medications & Pharmacogenetic Tests"

Vicki L. Ellingrod, Pharm.D., FCCP, is the Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Education in the College of Pharmacy at the University of Michigan. She is also a professor of Psychiatry and Psychology. Within the University of Michigan, helps to direct the Michigan Institute for Clinical and Health Research (MICHR), which provides training to other health professionals wanting training to do clinical research. She obtained her bachelors and PharmD from the University of Minnesota and then completed a postdoctoral fellowship in psychopharmacology/pharmacogenetics at the University of Iowa, followed by joining the faculty there as an assistant professor. Her research has focused on identification of genetic markers related to drug response in mental illness and has been funded by NIMH (National Institute of Mental Health) the FDA, and industry. Prior to joining the faculty at the University of Michigan, Dr. Ellingrod was a practicing clinical pharmacist working on the medical psychiatry unit at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.
