Registration Cost for Girls with Disabilities

Due to our commitment to make sure that cost is never a barrier to participation Michigan Disability Rights Coalition has established the following suggested registration options for this program. Remember this payment is all inclusive and pays for your food, lodging, personal care attendants, program costs, T-Shirts and Art Supplies and much higher than the options suggested. Please make checks out to “Her Power” and put “Her Registration” in the memo line.

- **Girls that will be paying the fee of the program out of their own money are asked to pay \$60**
- **Families that will be supporting the attendance of a girl are asked to pay \$90**
- **Organizations that will be supporting the attendance of a girl are asked to pay \$100**
- **\$100 or more who are able (any payment above \$90 is considered a tax deductible donation)**
