(For adults who interact with youth ages 12 -18)

## What is Mental Health First Aid?

Mental Health First Aid is the initial help given to a person showing symptoms of mental illness or in a mental health crisis (severe depression, psychosis, panic attack, suicidal thoughts and behaviors, etc.) until appropriate professional or other help, including peer and family support, can be engaged.

This 8-hour course prepares members of the community (family, school staff, clergy, 4-H Leaders, Girl/Boy Scout Leaders and more) to provide Mental Health First Aid to those in need. This course is delivered by a certified Mental Health First Aid USA instructor.
