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Maggie's Wigs 4 Kids of Michigan certified as a Site Location for Look Good, Feel Better Program

ST. CLAIR SHORES, Mich. (June 4, 2018) – Adults seeking support with the physical changes that occur with cancer treatment now have a new resource to receive the care they need. **Maggie's Wigs 4 Kids of Michigan Wellness Center** has recently been certified as a site location for the **Look Good Feel Better** program.

Look Good Feel Better is a non-medical, brand-neutral public service program that teaches beauty techniques to people with cancer to help them deal with the appearance-related side effects of treatment. The program includes lessons on skin and nail care, cosmetics, wigs and turbans, accessories & styling, helping patients restore a sense of normalcy to their life.

Maggie Varney, Founder & CEO has been a licensed facilitator of **Look Good Feel Better** for the past 29 years. "It's an honor and privilege to work with these patients," Maggie said. "When you are diagnosed; you're scared, worried about the side effects of your treatment plan and concerned what others think of your appearance. The **Look Good Feel Better** program addresses all of these issues and I have seen the joy in people's faces when they look in the mirror and see themselves again. They're ready to go back out into the world while fighting this terrible disease."

Classes for the **Look Good Feel Better** program start June 12th – 2:00 pm inside the **Wellness Center**. Additional workshops will be held once a month in July, August, October and November. The program is available to children and teens between the ages of 3 through 18 at no charge.
