The Garden Walk once again centers on the Historic Village of Warren area and Chicago Road, once a Native American trail between Ryan Road and continuing just east of Mound Road, with all new home gardens for 2025.

Visiting 11 locations, you will experience historic sites and gardens including the original 1922 Village Hall and its newly installed Native Plant Garden; the Village Bookstore; Historic Union Cemetery; a church from 1857 still in use today and a church designed by famed architect Minoru Yamasaki; Beebe's Corner Park with its gazebo and historical markers; and five private gardens. Your ticket will include the Warren Historical Society Historic Marker brochure so that you may visit other nearby sites not included on the Walk. This was the area of the first Garden Walks of the Warren Garden Club after it was established in 1937. Please join us for "Return to our Roots-Part II".
