Ornamental grasses and sedges are eye-catching landscape plants that bring texture, motion, and year-round appeal to home gardens. While they may look alike at first glance, grasses and sedges are distinct plant groups with different growth habits and benefits.

This engaging program explores why turf alternatives are worth considering and highlights low-maintenance plant options that can help diversify your landscape. Participants will learn about plant selection, installation, and annual care requirements.

Weather permitting, the program includes an outdoor walk through the MSU Extension–Macomb ornamental grasses and sedges garden. As an added bonus, a limited number of free ornamental grass plugs will be available for participants to take home.
